

2020 Vendor Rules, Regulations and Helpful Hints

Please note the changes to the 2020 event highlighted below!

Do Dah Day will be held on Saturday, May 16, 2020 in Caldwell Park ONLY. The park is located at 2500 Highland Ave. S. All vendors will be located on the STREET on Highland Avenue in between Niazuma Ave. and Milner Crescent. ONLY approved SPONSOR tents will be allowed INSIDE the park.

All vendors displaying and/or selling at DDD must submit an application, deposit and additional info as required. Vendor applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis until Friday, May 1, 2020. A 50% deposit is required with all vendor applications. (If applying via online form, you will receive an invoice for payment.)

Festival hours are from 11:01 a.m. - 4:01 p.m. Caldwell Park will be open for vendor set up beginning at 7:30 Saturday morning. You may bring one 10x10 tent, table and chairs for your display. Vendor tents, tables and chairs will not be provided. Automobile and other vehicular traffic is prohibited in the vendor area. All vendors should be ready for business by 10:00 a.m. There will be a quick, timely breakdown beginning at 4:01 p.m.

Vendors will check in at the intersection of Highland Ave S and Milner Cresent, and Do Dah Day staff will escort you to your booth location. Parking can become a problem after 10:00 a.m., so arrive early to secure a convenient space on the streets surrounding the park.

If you are cooking food, the Gas Inspector and Fire Marshall will inspect your tent/truck before opening. Please make sure you have ALL tax fees, licenses and permits cleared with Birmingham City PRIOR to May 1, 2019. Any food vendor NOT in compliance with Birmingham City regulations by May 1 will be subject to exclusion from the event. Do Dah Day is not responsible if codes and regulations are not met, and deposits will not be refunded.

All deliveries to the park must be cleared by Do Dah Day in advance, and must pass through designated vendor entrances ONLY. Security will allow you to park and unload, but cars left unattended for more than 15 minutes may be towed at owner expense.

Each year Do Dah Inc. sells collectible t-shirts, Coca-Cola products, various beverages and bottled water as a substantial part of its fundraising efforts. **Vendors may not sell or give away any t-shirts or competing beverages of any kind.**
